



Repair table operating instructions

Verify the RT30 Repair Table is in good working order before using. See the maintenance section of this manual.


1.) If the RT30 repair table is resting on it's (4) drop down legs, make sure there is clear egress to the

front (side opposite of panel storage pocket, Fig. 5) of the table. Roll either the Rotary LT33A or LT35A under the lift table and align the RT30 repair table locating brackets as shown in Fig. 1.




2.) Once the RT30 table locating brackets (yellow in color) are correctly located, raise the LT33A/35A lift table top up until the RT30 repair table's drop-down legs are off the floor, Fig. 2.


3.) Pull the spring-loaded drop-down leg release pin out and pivot the leg upward until the spring-loaded drop-down leg release pin "clicks" into it's parking location. Do this to all (4) legs, Fig. 3.




4.) Roll the lift table w/RT30 under the vehicle that needs servicing and set item on the RT30 repair table. If the table needs to be extended, slide both ends out the same amount until the RT30 repair tabletop is long enough. NOTE: At this time the sliding support can be slid into a position to support the plates, Fig. 4. Slide the appropriate panel from the panel storage pocket and fill the voids created by extending the ends.


NOTE: To remove/replace panels in storage pockets, slide end out to access panels, Fig. 4 & Fig. 5.

AWARNING The Rotary RT30 repair table is rated for 3000lb (1350kg) and must have the load centered at all times.





- 5.) If item needs major servicing, move the lift table w/ RT30 repair table out from under vehicle. Roll the lift table w/RT30 repair table to an empty relatively flat/level bay and lower drop-down locking legs. (Reverse of step 3.)
- 6.) Once all (4) drop-down legs are lowered, lower lift table until all (4) of the drop-down leg's feet are just touching the ground. If all (4) feet do not touch the ground at the same time, the RT30 repair table may be leveled by threading the feet in/out until the table is level, Fig 6.




- 7.) When the RT30 repair table is level the lift table may be lowered all the way and rolled out from under the RT30 repair table.
- 8.) When not in use the RT30 repair table may be stored on the lift table, resting on it's drop-down legs or stored on it's side against the wall.

Maintenance

- Oil detents, spring loaded drop-down leg retainer pins, drop-down leg pivot pins, threaded feet and retractable ends monthly using a lightweight penetrating oil.
- 2.) If rubber covers on panels are torn, burnt, or cracked, replace them with factory replacements.
- 3.) If the aluminum panels are bent and/or dented replace the entire panel assembly with a factory replacement panel.
- 4.) If any of the spring loaded drop-down leg retainer pins, drop-down leg pivot pins or "C" clips are damaged or missing replace with factory replacement parts.

- 5.) If the yellow table locator brackets are bent or missing replace them with factory replacement parts.
- 6.) If any attaching hardware, threaded feet, or jam nuts are damaged or missing replace them with factory replacement parts.
- 7.) If either of the sliding supports are damaged or missing replace them with factory replacement parts.
- 8.) If the drop-down legs are damaged or missing replace them with factory replacement parts.
- 9.) If the main frame is bent or damaged scrap and replace with a new factory unit.
